Hello Linda,

I live in the Parish at [REDACTED] in Lewannick.

I have previously been in contact with Michael White regarding a tree that has grown very big and blocks out daylight from my property as well as overhanging our land and property.

We have established that it borders with some unused land where there is a hedge between that land and the garden of [REDACTED] at the back of us and the tree is growing out of this hedge right next to our garden wall but they say that the hedge doesn't belong to them even though it's part of their. It has now become too large for us to tackle ourselves as we have been able to cut some branches off in the past that were brushing against our summer house roof with the risk of causing damage to it so I've been trying to find out who actually owns it for the last 12 months but to date had no luck in finding this out.

I contacted Derek Coyle from New Homes in Truro and passed on a contact number that Michael White had given me so that Derek could get permission to gain access and go on the land to see exactly where the tree is (Even though I've sent him numerous photographs of its location and he's been over to look at it from our back garden!)

I've not heard anything back since then but now would be a good time for somebody to look at it as the leaves have fallen off and it's a lot easier to see the tree and it's root base in order to work out who's land it is actually on.

I am registered sight-impaired as I am going blind and find it extremely difficult to see in both poor light and artificial light so somebody needs to either trim the branches taking it down in height or take it down altogether if it's not protected.

Are you able to help with this in any way please?
