
Christmas Tree Collection



I hope that you all enjoyed the Tree lights over the Christmas period, the tree was subjected to some very bad weather particularly storm Darragh where the first set of lights stopped working! We hastily sought a new set of lights which had a lot more lamps than before. These lights weathered better than the previous set and may I say were quite stunning. We managed to raise £115.60p between the shop, pub and Sunday quiz night, with gift aid the donation was £143.75p which has been donated to Childrens Hospice South West, Little Harbour. I would like to thank Trebartha Estates for donating the tree, NRS Transport (Nick Smith) and his helpers for collecting and erecting the tree. This year for disposal the tree was collected by a resident and given to their goats which is more environmentally friendly than what is usually done. I believe that this is the last year that Trebartha can donate a tree and also the last year that I will be able to affix the lights. If a tree can be sorted for this year, I can supply all the necessary electrical gear and wire stays to whoever takes on the role. We have been having a tree for the last 16-17 years and it would be a shame if we have had our last one.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone who has supported the Tree and lights over the years, it has brought a little bit of happiness and raised money for charity.
