PARISH COUNCIL

The Parish Council met on Tuesday 18th March in Lewannick.

Planning

PA25/01082 Tinney Hall Grainstore, this was supported.

PA24/06651 Planning decisions notified by Cornwall Council, this was Refused. Unitary Councillor's Report.

It has been announced today that Cornwall Housing is doing away with local connections for housing; those in most need will have priority wherever they are from. The budget setting is still ongoing at Cornwall Council with £173m to be provided for the creation of new school places and buildings. CC is looking for modern ways to support Carbon Zero. £250,000 has been set aside for the junction at Plusha. The Cornwall Councillors Community Chest funding will be reduced. The full report is available on the Councillors official face book page.

Parish Matters.

Telephone box at Lewannick refurb, the Clerk is going to check on progress. Highway and Footpath Matters.

A30/B3257 junction at Bodmin Moor Services (Plusha). Update from SPAG circulated and noted. The funding of £250k from Cornwall Council is towards putting the business case together for

the junction.

Footpaths

We have a contractor who has agreed to undertake the cutting of the footpaths. **Blackhill Quarry.**

The boundary hedges of the quarry are overgrown and brambles etc. are scraping passing vehicles. Some vegetation has been cut down but has been left in the lay-by. The Clerk will write and ask for all debris to be removed and for the rest of the boundary hedges to be cut back.

Trevadlock.

The Clerk has reported the potholes, flooding and mud on the road and has been advised that the Highway Steward will visit tomorrow to look at the problems.
